The HRH Global Resource Center eLearning program offers free courses developed by technical experts in the fields of human resources for health, health informatics and health service delivery to build the capacity of country-based users in critical skills development.



The program runs on low-bandwidth friendly, open source software and offers selfpaced courses that include modular lessons, quizzes, audio and video instruction, and transcripts designed to meet a number of different learning needs.
